Grip and traction

The Hellkat achieved the highest cornering traction in its category (Enduro Race) with 10/10 points. 9.5/10 points for traction are on par with the Schwalbe Magic Mary SG and slightly exceeding the Maxxis Minion DHF.

Protection

Highest puncture protection in the test with a measured 180 N. Resisted pinch flats falling down from a height up to 1050 mm, same as Schwalbe.

Weight

Competing against folding bead tires, the wire bead version of the Hellkat showed a competitive weight of 1172 g, weighing slightly less than the Maxxis and only 56 g more than the Schwalbe.

• Price

The Hellkat was the most affordable tire in its category with a RRP of 52,90 Euro compared to 62,90 Euro for the Schwalbe and 74,50 Euro for the Maxxis.

Weight

Tested with KSCT protection, the Saber was still one of the lightest tires in the test with 610 q.

Rolling resistance

With a tested rolling resistance of 19,9 watt, the Saber with R3C compound was one of the top 3 fastest rolling tires in the test.
